### Section 4 (1) (b)

### i) The particulars of organization, functions and duties

The Department of Handlooms and Textiles is concerned with Handlooms, Powerlooms in the Cooperative and decentralized sector and Coop. Spinning Mills.

The Director of Handlooms and Textiles is charged with the responsibility of supervision over the working of Weavers Coop. Societies (Cotton & Wool / Silk), Powerloom Societies, Garment Manufacturing Coop. Societies, Processing & Sizing Coop. Societies, Tailor Coop. Societies, Coop. Spinning Mills and APEX organizations.

He is also vested with statutory and regulatory functions being the Registrar of Primary Weavers Coop. Societies such as Inspections, Inquiries Arbitrations, Executions, Liquidations under A.P. Cooperative Societies Act,1964. He is assisted by officers of various categories at District and Taluk level. He is the Registrar of Cooperative Societies under the A.P. Cooperative Societies Act for all purposes so far as the Handloom and Powerloom Cooperatives are concerned.

The subordinate offices of the Department are, apart from the 3 Regional Offices, the offices of the Assistant Director (H&T) covering all the districts in the State. There are 12 offices of Assistant Directors (H&T) in 13 Districts. Visakhapatnam District is attached additionally to the jurisdiction of the Assistant Director (H&T), Vizianagaram.



### STATE SCHEMES:

### 1. <u>Y.S.R. NETHANNA NESTHAM:</u>

- ➢ Government of Andhra Pradesh announced to provide Rs.24,000/- per annum to every weaver family to help them to modernize their equipment and compete with the powerloom sector.
- Government issued orders through G.O.Ms.No. 89, III & C (Prog-II) Dept, dated 23.10.2019 to implement YSR Nethanna Nestham Scheme for providing Rs.24,000/- per annum to every weaver family who owns a Handloom.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- All Handloom Weavers who owns a Handloom and actually engaged in Handloom Weaving and eking their livelihood from Weaving.
- **2.** One Weaver family shall be eligible for only one benefit irrespective of the number of looms owned by them.
- **3.** The Weaver family shall belong to the Below Poverty Line (BPL) category.

In addition to these, the following Operational guidelines were also issued to all Village/Ward Secretariats, MPDOs, Municipal Commissioners and Assistant Directors (H&T) for identification of eligible beneficiaries:

- **1.** The Weavers who are working in sheds owned by PHWCSs and Master Weavers are not eligible under the Scheme.
- **2.** The persons who are engaged in allied works such as Winding, Warping, Sizing, Dyeing, Piecing etc., are not eligible under the Scheme.
- The Hon'ble Chief Minister has launched the Scheme on 21.12.2019 at Dharmavaram in Ananthapuramu District and released Rs196.28 Crs. to 81783 Weavers through DBT. T he Details are

# 3. <u>40% SUBSIDY ON PURCHASE OF RAW MATERIALS, DYES & CHEMICALS FROM NHDC</u> <u>AND APCO:</u>

- The Objective of the Scheme is to Supply quality and branded Hank yarn, Dyes and Chem icals through NHDC and APCO to Handloom Weavers Co-operative Societies for productio n of quality Handloom Fabrics in the State under subsidized prices from 2008.
- Government in the G.O.Ms.No.55, I&C (Prog-II) Dept, Dt: 08.03.2019, ordered for enhanc ement of Yarn Subsidy from 20 to 40% on Purchase of Yarn, Dyes and Chemicals from N HDC and APCO by HWCSs in the State.
- Out of 40% Yarn subsidy, 75% amount will be credited directly to the members Bank acc ounts of the concerned Primary Weavers Cooperative Societies as Production bonus basin g on the wages earned by them and furnish quarterly reports along with bank details of t he members to Director, Handlooms and Textiles.
- The societies may utilize the remaining 25% of the amount out of 40% Yarn subsidy for giving Rebate on sales or for any other production purpose.

# 7. OLD AGE PENSIONS TO WEAVERS:

- Under the Scheme Financial Assistance (Pension) will be provided as Social Security to the Old Aged eligible Weavers.
- The age of Weaver Pensioner is reduced from 65 to 50 years, as a special case because of crippling effect in Weaving Profession by the State Govt vide G.O.Rt.No.278, I&C (Tex) dept., dt: 14.10.2005.
- Pension @ Rs. 2,250/- per month is being distributed to 1,09,973 Weavers who are above 50 years.

# 8. **POWERLOOM INDUSTRY:**

About 35,600 Power Looms working in the State mostly concentrated in Chittoor, Anan tapuramu, Kadapa, and Kurnool Districts. District wise Details of Power Looms are as follows:

# 9. POWER TARIFF CONCESSION TO POWERLOOM UNITS:

- With a view to provide Relief to Power Loom Units, which are facing crisis on account o f increase in Power Tariff, Government have reduced the Power Tariff for the Power Loo m Units by 50% per unit up to 5 HP Load Capacity since 2001.
- 10,475 Power Loom Units are getting benefit under the Scheme Government accorded permission for continuation of Scheme w.e.f 01.04.2010 vides G.O.Rt.No.691 I&C (Tex) dept., dt: 04.12.2013.
- Govt. also Ordered Exemption of 100% Fuel Sur Charge Adjustment (FSA) to Power LoomUnits who are availing 50% Power Tariff Concession vide G.O.Rt.No.173 I&C (Tex) dept., dt:02.05.2014.

- Minimum Loan per Loom for Cotton products is Rs. 50,000/- and Rs. 1.00 Lakh for Silk P roducts and maximum limit is Rs. 5.00 Lakh.
- Margin money assistance @ 20% of the Project Cost subject to a maximum of Rs. 10,000/
   per Weaver will be provided.
- > The maximum Interest Subvention would be 7%.
- Credit Guarantee for (3) years through Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE).
- Margin Money, Interest subsidy will be provided by the office of the DCH directly to the b anks.

# **3. MARKETING INCENTIVE:**

- Marketing Incentive Scheme is being implemented under National Handloom Development Program.
- The object of the scheme is to enhance competitiveness of Handloom products in the open market.
- Marketing Incentive is provided to eligible PWCS, APEX Cooperative societies, APCO & APHDC at the financial ceiling of 10% of the average sales turnover of the last 3 years of the respective beneficiary, which shall be shared in ratio of 50:50 between GOI & State Government. Under the scheme guidelines the State government has to release their portion of 50 % claim amount before claiming for Government of India share.
- An upper cap of Rs.30 lakh of annual turnover is fixed for eligibility for release of marketing incentive so that needy societies are covered within the available budget.
- Societies having more than an annual turnover of Rs.30 lakh are not eligible for MI.
- Currently the claims pertaining to Marketing Incentive scheme have to be paid from the year 2013-14 to 2017-18 are as follows:

- The Government of Andhra Pradesh also in order to achieve the desired objectives have launched **Textile & Apparel Policy 2015-20 (TAP)** for the comprehensive developmen t of Textile Sector extending various incentives, fiscal benefits and concessions for enco uraging establishment of New Industrial Units in the State.
- The Government of A.P, in collaboration with the Government of India have taken initi ative in establishing (14) various parks comprising (2) Apparel Parks, (5) Textile Parks a nd (6) Parks under the Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks(SITP) of Government of I ndia under Public Private partnership (PPP) in the State.

# 1. <u>Hindupur Vyapar Apparel Park, Hindupur, Anantapuramu Dist. (SITP, GOI Project</u>

- )
- The Hindupur Vyapar Apparel Park, Hindupur, Anantapuramu District was sanctio ned in the year 2005-06 under SITP to be set up in 73.10 acres of land with a proje ct cost of Rs.102.27 crores comprising of GoI grant of Rs.40.00 crores and SPV sha re Rs.62.27 crores.
- > Activities proposed are weaving, sizing, warping and garmenting.
- Govt. of India released Rs.24.00 crores as grant and the State Govt. has released R s.0.50 crores towards external infrastructure (power supply).
- > The SPV has partially completed the construction of 3 buildings.
- The Textile Commissioner in the meeting held on 27.03.2016 has advised the SPV to bring new investors and submit a revival plan to the Project Management Committee (PMC).
- The SPV identified new investors viz., Indian Designs Exports Private Limited (IDEP L) to invest in the park for revival. They have agreed to set up state of the art faciliti es at Hindupur Vyapar Apparel Park, (HVAP).
- The PAC in the meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> January, 2017 approved the revision in the DP R on the conditions that the project would be completed within 36 months from the date of issue of approval and the next release will be given only when SPV spends R s.60.00 crore on the project excluding the expenditure on land & machinery. Plans and estimates for external infrastructure are under preparation.

# 2. Brandix Lanka at Visakhapatnam (SEZ)

- > The Brandix India Apparel City Pvt. Ltd., Achutapuram, Vizag was sanctioned in the ye ar 2005-06 in Scheme for Integrated Textile Park (SITP).
- The Mega project is set up in 1000 acres of SEZ land which was given to the Brandix, a Srilankan Company on lease @ Re.1/- per acre per annum for a period of 25 years.
- > Outlay of the project is Rs.143.09 crores.
- The amount of Rs.104.59 crores released (Govt. of India Rs.40.00 crores + Govt. of A.P., Rs.64.59 crores).
- 17 units have been established in the Park for different manufacturing activities and t he units are functioning.
- As per the MoU, the company has to provide employment to 60000 local unemployed y outh over period of (5) years.
- > The Park has provided employment to (18000) youth till date.

# 3. MAS Fabric Park (India) Pvt. Ltd., Chintavaram, SPSR Nellore Dist. (SEZ)

- The MAS Fabric Park (India) Pvt. Ltd. Chintavaram, SPSR Nellore dist., was sanctioned in the year 2005-06 under SITP with Project cost of Rs.254.70 crores, with GoI grant o f Rs.40.00 crores.
- APIIC has allotted 714 acres of land in Chintavaram (V) and Company purchased 22 a cres.
